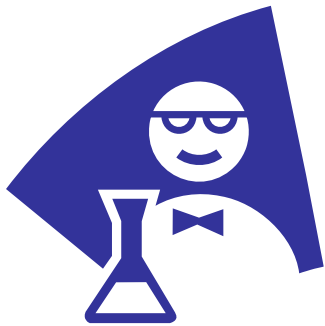

Topics to be discussed during the course includes vascular wall physiology, atherosclerosis, hypertension, thrombosis, inflammation of the vessel wall, imaging of heart and vessels, diagnostics and treatment of cardiovascular disease. A main objective of the course is to illustrate and strengthen translation of research into clinical practice by giving pre-clinical students insight into clinical practice.
